

Definition

Five Paradigms

- 1 Plurality of knowledge resources everyday knowledge, professional knowledge, autochthon knowledge, etc.
- 2 Plurality of actors in knowledge production researchers, professionals, students
- 3 Plurality of participation opportunities citizen science, fablabs, do-it-yourself cultures, real life labs
- 4 Plurality of tasks and renegotiation of roles of responsibility accountability, duty of care, liability
- 5 Plurality of educational biographies and knowledge paths
